EYFS - Y6

YEAR 5

Young Leaders.
Take part in a Careers Session with a Civil Engineer.
Opportunity to apply for Leeds Child Mayor. Articulate what they are good at and how this would govern success within a role.
Confidently question employers around their roles.
Develop awareness of next steps in Post-16 education.
Participate in Careers Fair- evaluating how this impacts aspirations as well as challenging stereotypes in the world of work.
Enrichment through religious and historical experiences as well as virtual Q & A while exploring Careers stereotypes.
Participate in Careers Fair.

YEAR 6

Have a secure understanding of themselves in the context of their skills and interests and how this links to future employment.
Take part in a Careers Session with Doctor and Leadership Learning Planning Lead for the Department of pensions.
Young Leaders, Peer Mediators.
Have used Skills Builder sessions to develop and evaluate skills.
Know how to celebrate themselves through Careers interviews and mock application processes.
Participate in events linked to Careers to practise skills in context.
Know and reflect on different industries and sectors.
Enrichment through Residential, trip to Filey and Enterprise Week as well as mock application and interviews in WoW week (June 2026).
Participate in Careers Fair.

YEAR 3

Develop a secure understanding of strength and weaknesses related to which jobs they might enjoy and be successful at in the future.
Take part in a Careers Session with a Evidence and Impact Manager.
Talk about aspirations for skills and jobs that they might want in the future.
Show an understanding of the pathways to achieve this.
Develop understanding of jobs in different sectors.
Enrichment through a trip to Magna.
Participate in Careers Fair.

YEAR 4

Young Leaders.
Know what is needed to achieve a job they aspire to do.
Confidently talk about Careers skills as part of learning.
Take part in a Careers Session with a Civil Servant.
Understand how skills relate to employment vs self-employment.
Have further experiences of workplaces and employers in different sectors.
Self-evaluate which were enjoyable and why this was.
Enrichment through trips to Yorkshire Sculpture Park.

YEAR 1

Spend one Retrieval Practice session per week discussing our 'Skill of the Week'
Take part in a Careers Session with Leeds Teaching Hospital.
Understand that different jobs require different skills, listening, speaking, teamwork, leading etc.
Have some experiences of meeting and interacting with people who have different jobs.
Enrichment through trips to....(tbc)
Participate in Careers Fair.

YEAR 2

Spend one Retrieval Practice session per week discussing our 'Skill of the Week'
Begin to understand which skills they are good at and which might need work.
Develop further awareness of jobs beyond public services.
Take part in a Careers Session with a Seamstress.
Begin Linking curriculum learning to Careers skills
Enrichment through trips to Filey.
Participate in Careers Fair.

EYFS

Begin to learn about the world of work and key jobs (Police, medical, emergency services, Understand different sorts of jobs and that school is important to get a job in the future)
Inspiring children and young people in health and care roles with visits from Leeds Teaching Hospitals.
Have an introduction to skills builder through language and stories.
Enrichment through trips to Temple Newsham & Carriageworks.
